

STATEMENT OF WORK

These deliverables apply to this individual practice. For other planned practice deliverables refer to those specific Statements of Work.

DESIGN

Deliverables:

1. Design documents that demonstrate criteria in NRCS practice standard have been met and are compatible with planned and applied practices
 - a. Practice purpose(s) as identified in the conservation plan.
 - b. List of required permits to be obtained by the client and regulations to be met
 - i. **Compliance with NRCS national and state utility safety policy (NEM Part 503-Safety, Subpart A- Engineering Activities Affecting Utilities 503.00 through 503.06 and 210-VI-EFH, Amendment WV-45, Nov. 1996- WV5-23 Engineering Field Handbook) and all engineering activities affecting utilities. This includes contacting and documenting MISS UTILITY 1-800-248-4848 according to West Virginia Chapter 24-C, Underground Facility Damage Prevention act. The law makes it a requirement to notify the state of West Virginia before any excavation or demolition activities are done.**
 - c. List of facilitating practices
 - d. Practice standard criteria-related computations and analyses to develop plans and specifications including but not limited to:
 - i. Targeted emissions and source
 - ii. Emission reductions requirements, if needed
 - iii. Reduction calculations, analysis, etc.
2. Written plans and specifications including sketches and drawings shall be provided to the client that adequately describes the requirements to install the practice and obtain necessary permits.
3. Operation and maintenance plan
4. Certification that the design meets practice standard criteria and comply with applicable laws and regulations
5. Design modifications during installation as required

Note: Design of practice will be in compliance with practice standard and applicable criteria for the appropriate purpose(s). Practice specification will include the information listed in the "Plans and Specifications" and "Operation and Maintenance" section of the conservation practice standard. The design will document the clients' decisions using narrative and/or jobsheet.

INSTALLATION

Deliverables

1. Pre-installation conference **with client to review/document problem, alternatives considered, decisions made and agreed to solution.**
2. Verification that client has obtained required permits
3. Installation guidance as needed
4. Facilitate and implement required design modifications with client and original designer
5. Advise client/NRCS on compliance issues with all federal, state, tribal, and local laws, regulations and NRCS policies during installation
6. Certification that the installation process and materials meets design and permit requirements

CHECK OUT

Deliverables

1. Records of application
 - a. Extent of practice units applied
 - b. Actual materials used
2. Certification that the application meets NRCS standards and specifications and is in compliance with permits
3. Progress reporting
