SPECIFICATIONS
Obstruction Removal (500)

1. APPLICABILITY

Construction Specification 500 is applicable to obstruction removal of unwanted or hazardous buildings, structures, vegetation, debris or other materials.

2. ITEMS TO BE INCLUDED IN SECTION 6 AND /OR DRAWINGS

- a. Plan view location and dimensions of obstruction removal and other proposed practices, including access limitations.
- b. Describe method of removal and disposal.
- c. Earthwork requirements; including cut and fill limits.
- d. Location of borrow, spoil, and/or disposal areas(s), if required.
- e. Identify permit needs where applicable. Include WV 811, Miss Utility of West Virginia 1-800-245-4848.
- f. Temporary and permanent vegetative and /or mulching requirements.
- g. Reference to other practice standards and specifications, if applicable.
- h. Erosion and sediment control.
- i. Vegetation

3. EARTHFILL

Place fill according to the required compaction along with moisture content as shown on the drawings or attached.

4. VEGETATION

Vegetation, if required, shall be established at the locations shown on the drawings and/or staked in the field. All disturbed areas shall be revegetated according to the recommendations for permanent seeding as stated in Conservation Practice Standard 342, Critical Area Planting or the Pennsylvania Agronomy Guide.

5. EROSION AND POLLUTION CONTROL

Construction operations will be carried out in such a manner that erosion and air and water pollution will be minimized. State and local laws concerning pollution abatement must be followed.

6. STRUCTURE REMOVAL

Reference the limits of the obstruction and manmade structure removal as shown on the drawings. Do not disturb trees, wetlands, other structures or protected areas as designated on the drawings.

Adhere to the disposal methods and areas as designated on the drawings and finish grade of disposal of excavated material.

7. UTILITIES

Verify all utilities have been properly notified, marked and posted, and turned off prior to commencing removal or obstructions.
