

RESOURCE CONCERNS

Plants

Suitability

- a. **Plants not suitable** – Plants do not meet the objectives of the land user, are not well adapted to the site or are unsuitable for intended use.

Quality Criteria: Plant (s) selection or management will be suitable for the intended use and adapted to the soil and climatic conditions of the area. When established plants are not well adapted, are noxious, or are poisonous and an individual does not choose to change the plant (s) or land use, or modify the site, criteria will be met as long as other resources are not adversely affected.

Condition

- a. **Productivity** – Plants do not provide the desired quality or quantity of crops, forage or cover.

Quality Criteria: Plant (s) selection or management will overcome the constraining conditions to provide quality and quantity of plant production based upon appropriate standard for Grazing Land (528A); Upland Wildlife (645); Wetland Wildlife (644); Hayland (511); or Cropland (328).
