This is the first of a new series of technical notes in the field of engineering which is being established in the state.

The purpose of this first issue is to acquaint everyone with the plans and procedures regarding these notes.

1. Starting July 1, 1964 a monthly issue of technical notes in engineering will be prepared under the direction of the State Conservation Engineer and distributed to all field locations.
2. These notes are intended for in-service use and reference by field personnel. They are not intended for hand out or job sheet type of material. It is suggested that each location establish a three ring binder to contain these notes as part of their Technical Guides.
3. It is planned that each issue will deal only with a single subject in the field of engineering. Write-up will be kept in as non-technical terms as possible .
4. The intent of the notes will be to convey useable information on the whys and hows of engineering fundamentals, methods, principles, policies and procedures.
5. All field personnel are strongly urged to advise the State Conservation Engineer through channels of subject matter they would like to see covered in these technical notes. This can be done at any time.
