

FIRE CRACKED ROCK ATTRIBUTES

Stone is affected by fire in different ways, from extreme discoloration (usu. red, white, or shades of gray) to no discoloration (notice black rock at top of feature), and from extreme cracking or crazing to no noticeable breakage. Surface indications of hearths or fire features can be uniform and circular, such as this example from central Wyoming.
