**MINIMUM SPECIFICATIONS:**

Consider the following list of items when planning the practice. These items are the minimum documentation requirements:

1. Location on conservation plan map
2. Acres and how determined
3. Soil map unit information
4. Completed WIN-PST report: Interpretations of the environmental risk analysis and identification of appropriate mitigating practices and techniques, including "PAMS" strategy
5. Completed WEPS for Wind Erosion and RUSLE2 for Water Erosion Prediction Calculations
6. Location of sensitive resources and setbacks, if applicable
7. References from Land Grant University, High Plains IPM for mitigating greater than low risk pesticides, and Wyoming Agronomy Technical Note 30 Pest Management in the Conservation Planning Process

Record the minimum specifications for this practice in the conservation plan narrative, appropriate jobsheet, or the conservation assistance notes.
