Other sources of Effects Information

1. Evaluations From Other Programs

The backup data for studies conducted for other programs may have conservation effects available in them. (RC&D plans, watershed plans, or river basin studies).

2. Studies By Outside Agencies

Studies conducted by outside agencies, such as local universities or Extension Service, can shed light on the effects of conservation and on the problems and opportunities of new technologies. These studies should be carefully reviewed for information that can be used.

3. Models

Occasionally, pieces of information are difficult to measure, particularly through onsite observation or working with clients. Some of these pieces of information may be valuable in informing the client of the effects of certain conservation alternatives.

Some examples of Models are:

- AGNIPS (Agricultural Non-Point Source Pollution Program)
- GLA (Grazing Lands Application)
- RUSLE (Revised Universal Soil Loss Equation)
