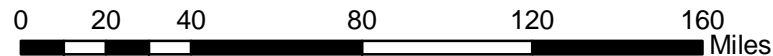
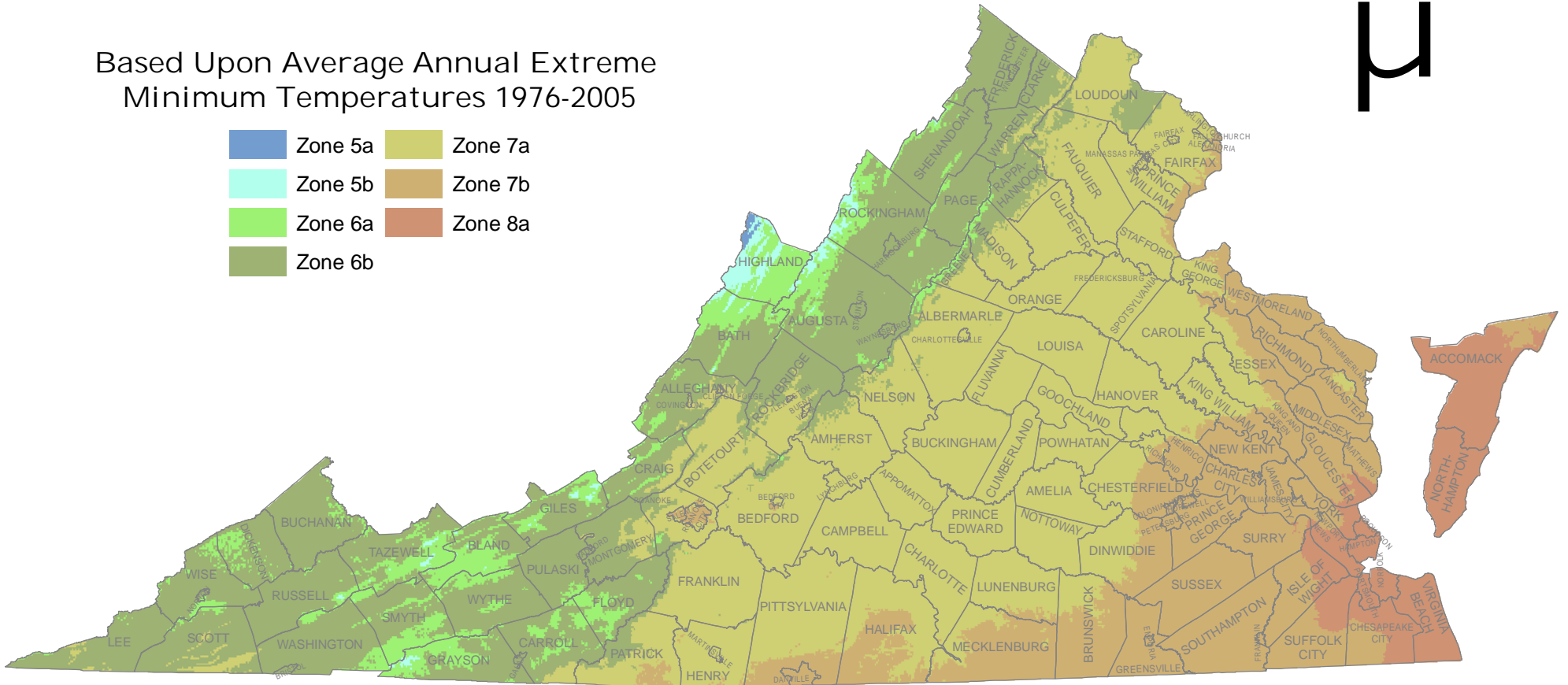




PLANT HARDINESS ZONES of VIRGINIA
